
## **Choking Anatomy**



- · In the back of the mouth are two openings.
- One is the <u>esophagus</u>, which leads to the stomach; food goes down this pathway.
- The other is the <u>trachea</u>, which is the opening air must pass through to get to the lungs.
- When swallowing occurs, the trachea is covered by a flap called the <u>epiglottis</u>, which prevents food from entering the lungs.
